Update from Mr Brough

This weekend the year 6 students took part in Shelter Camp on the school field, although they were all rather soggy come Saturday morning, we were pleased to be able to continue with this planned activity in their last few weeks with us at Corvedale.

Unfortunately there are some events which we will have to change to allow them to continue, and this does include Sports day. We will still be holding a sports day on Friday (9th July) however, the guidance we have received means we cannot allow parents to attend this event - rest assured we will do our utmost to ensure all children are encouraged and enjoy themselves whilst participating in the many events and activities throughout the day. Please can you make sure children come to school in suitable PE Kits with water bottles, hats and sun cream as appropriate.

As mentioned in the last newsletter, the school will be running the pre-school provision and wrap around care in September, and we have been busy trying to establish if we can offer any childcare for the upcoming summer holidays. This has proved extremely tricky due to the amount of time we have had to try and arrange, logistics of staffing, and also certain refurbishments that will be being undertaken throughout the summer in the setting. Unfortunately upon evaluation this has meant on this occasion we will be unable to offer such additional childcare, but confirm that once we are up and running in September we will again look into this if we are able to provide this service for those parents who need it. I believe the work required this summer will allow us to maintain a smooth transition and really hit the ground running in September - We encourage all parents of 2, 3 and 4 year olds within the area to make contact via the school office for further information regarding the Pre-School setting, and also anyone wishing to book in for wrap around care can also do so via the admin@corvedaleprimary.co.uk email.
