#### **Message from The Governors**

The Governing Body wish to congratulate the staff and pupils on the further acknowledgement they've received in the press for their outstanding performance in the 2023/24 Key Stage 2 results as detailed below. Results and tables for the 2024/25 results are not yet available but yet again we had a pleasing set of results. The 'best-performing' primary schools in Shropshire have been revealed in a new national league table created by The Telegraph. The ranking draws on data from the 2023/24 academic year, measuring factors such as exam results, class sizes, and pupil progress. Here are the best primary schools in Shropshire, according to The Telegraph:

1<sup>st</sup> Norbury Primary School and Nursery 2<sup>nd</sup> St Lucia's CofE Primary School & Nursery 3<sup>rd</sup> Rushbury CofE Primary School 4<sup>th</sup> Corvedale CofE Primary School

Rating: 36/40. 86% of pupils met KS2 standard. The average score in reading, writing and maths (out of 120) was 106.3. As with any organisation we have had a staff change over the 6 weeks holidays.
