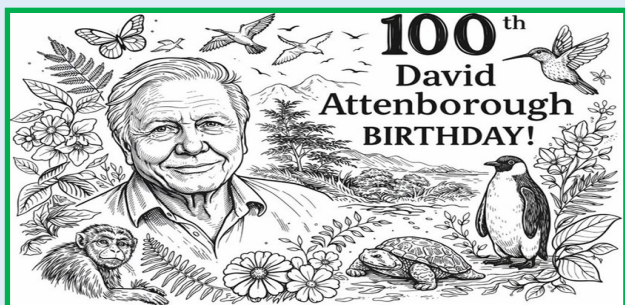
Update from Mrs Rook
